

## CLUB RULES, FORT ATKINSON MUZZLELOADERS

1. Nothing but muzzleloaders may be fired on the property. **No** cartridge guns allowed! We are only zoned for **muzzleloader** rifles, shotguns and handguns! Violators will be subject to expulsion from the club.
2. Trapping by members for personal use only (in season and with license).
3. Hunting by members only with muzzleloaders (in season and with license). No bow hunting is allowed.
4. Trash --- CARYY IN, CARRY OUT. Please take all of your trash with you when leaving.
5. No firing muzzleloaders in the river. Except for hunting during open season, no guns should be discharged anywhere on the property except on the range. Farmers may be working in nearby fields or other members may be on the property, fishing, etc. You are urged to check behind the impact area before beginning a shooting session.
6. Limit of four (4) guests per member. They may target shoot, camp, fish, canoe, swim and hike. The member must be present at the Club with the guests and is responsible for guests' behavior and actions. (Larger groups require prior club approval.)
7. Loaning a key to an unauthorized person is grounds for expulsion.
8. No firewood is to leave the property. It should be understood that only dead timber be cut for firewood. Please practice conservation by burning only what you need, so that our wood supply will last for many years to come.
9. No glass or plastic bottles, pop or beer cans are allowed to be used for targets.
10. All motor vehicles must stay on designated roads and designated parking areas.
11. All fires must be put out before leaving the club property.
12. Parents must accompany children on the Club's property, and parents are responsible for their children's safety and supervision.
13. No young adults (under 17) are to be at the Club (camping, shooting, hunting or hiking, etc.) without a parent or the sponsoring club member present to supervise them. When family members turn age 17, they may apply for membership or be put on the Club's waiting list, but they still must be with the parent member if they go to the range.
14. General firing range rules will be enforced at all time at the club. Rules are posted at the range.
15. No donations to the club in lieu of dues. Everyone works and everyone pays. If you can't make a work-day, you should try to volunteer to do projects that can be done at other times.
16. Be considerate of our neighbors and respect their property. We appreciate and depend upon their good will. Each member needs to know where our land ends and where a neighbor's beings! Our land across the river can only be access by crossing the river. You must acquire permission from the neighboring landowners if you wish to go on their property.
17. Always lock the gate except during organized club functions such as meetings and shoots.
