

RANGE RULES, FORT ATKINSON MUZZLELOADERS

1. Nothing but muzzleloaders may be fired on the property.
2. No smoking or consumption of alcohol on the loading or firing line.
3. No loading directly from horn, flask or can. Use separate powder measure.
4. No open powder containers on loading benches or firing line.
5. No priming or capping until at the firing line with muzzle pointed down range.
6. Muzzle up when carrying loaded firearms between loading benches and firing line.
7. Load and shoot from the same numbered position on the loading benches and firing line.
8. No blowing down the barrel.
9. No handling firearms when people are down range.
10. All shooting to be done on the range, except during hunting season with current permit.
11. No loaded firearms in the clubhouse or camp.
12. Targets shall be paper, blue rock, metal silhouettes or degradable items such as eggs or briquettes. No glass or metal containers used as targets.
13. All shooters under the age of 18 must have supervision by adult club member.
14. Ear and eye protection is recommended for all shooters. It is required for junior and sub-junior shooters during organized shoots.
15. Be mindful of possible farming activities beyond the backstops.
16. At the conclusion of shooting, retrieve all shot targets.
17. At the conclusion of shooting, police the firing line and dispose of patches, cap boxes and other debris.
18. NMLRA rules apply at all organized club shoots. The range officer's word is law.
